Dr. Stephen Sonstein has spent his entire career in academia, serving as faculty member, program director, department head and assistant dean at Eastern Michigan University, University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, University of Dayton and Columbus College. He earned a BS from Rutgers University and a PhD in Microbiology and Biochemistry from Hahnemann Medical College and has conducted basic, preclinical and clinical research in the area of antibiotic mechanism of action and antibiotic resistance, is a Fellow of the American Academy of Microbiology and holds national office in the American Society for Microbiology. He is currently Professor and Director of Clinical Research Administration at Eastern Michigan University where he developed and currently directs one of the first programs which offered academic credit and a degree in Clinical Research Administration. He was a founding member of the Consortium of Academic Programs in Clinical Research.
